Inspired by the vision that everyone deserves a decent place to live, Habitat for Humanity South Australia partners with organisations and individuals through safe, affordable housing.

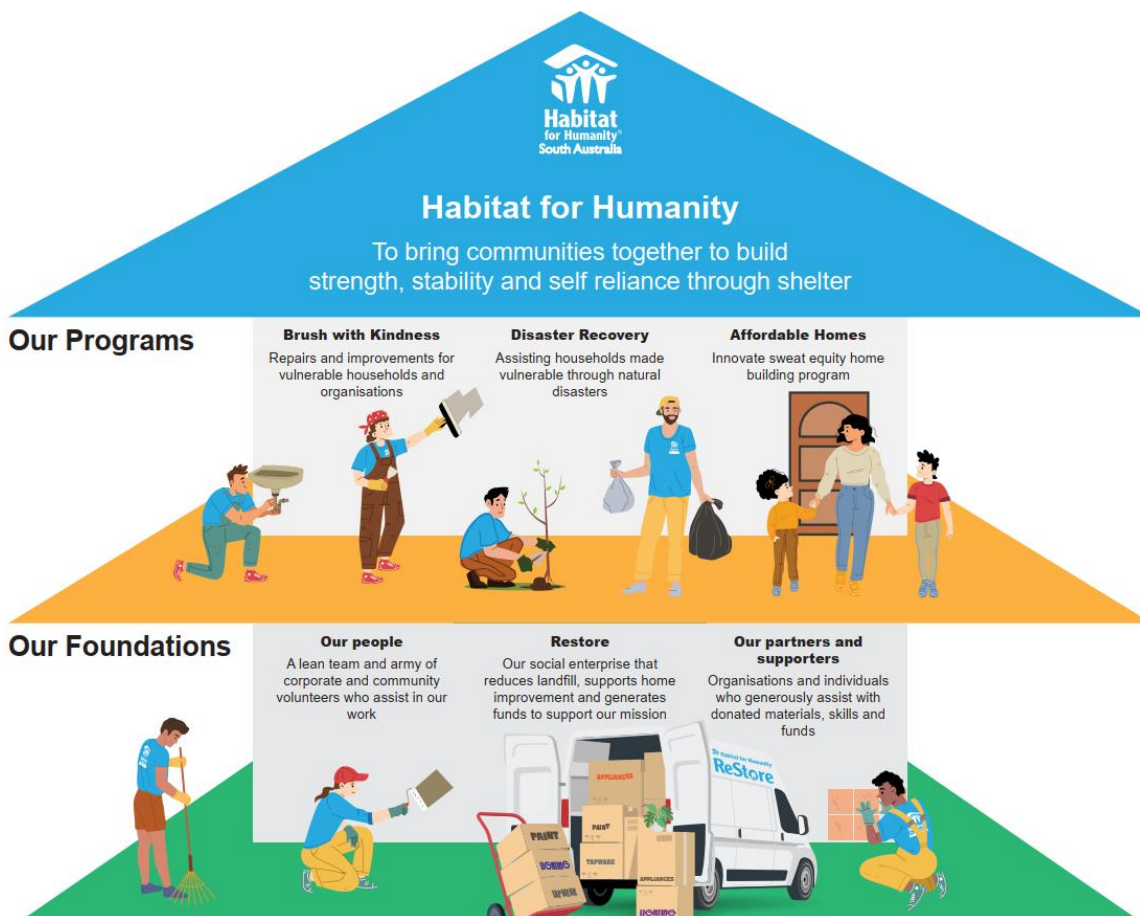

Affordable Homes Program

Over the past 30 years HFHSA has supported 40 families, in exceptional circumstances, into affordable home ownership. This program builds on Habitat's unique sweat equity model and is made possible through the generous support from trades and businesses across South Australia.

We recently built a home in Two Wells for the [Lovett family](#) to provide a stable home for their children, two of which have rare medical condition. The Lovett's had to relocate from Port Lincoln to access specialist medical services. In 2025/26, with the on-going, generous support from HPG Homes and partners, we are building two homes for families that are both fostering children with special needs.

How it works

1. Habitat for Humanity (SA) application and selection process
2. Home loan assessment (our partner families typically seek finance through HomeStart)
3. Construction at 75% or less than 'market' (made possible through the generosity of our supporters)
4. HFHA SA mortgage on deed to ensure that Habitat's contribution is protected.

Application and selection process

- Exceptional circumstances
- Experiencing housing stress
- Don't currently own home/property
- Need to live in the Habitat home
- Low income
- Willing to contribute to Habitat for Humanity

We are currently seeking Expressions of Interest for new partner families. Habitat for Humanity selects partner families in accordance with the Affordable Homes Program Criteria. There are limited opportunities each year, and families are selected on a needs-basis. Habitat for Humanity is committed to equal opportunity and non-discrimination in accordance with our values and policies.
